PRIVACY NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

In the following we will inform you in accordance with Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) the collection of personal data.

1. Responsible for data collection

2. Purpose of the (time-limited) data collection

The purpose of the (time-limited) data collection is health protection at the "Mut zum Hut" sales show, Army Museum/New Castle, Ingolstadt, Art 6 Paragraph 1 Clause 1 lit. GDPR. The data will be in response to the pandemic spread of the Coronavirus Sars-CoV-2 and the associated reportable Covid-19 infectious disease collected, in particular for prevention and, just in case, of traceability (subsequent precaution towards the contact persons). It will personal data are only processed to the extent that this is necessary.

3. Data confidentiality

The organizer treats the data as strictly confidential, exclusively used for a specific purpose and deleted immediately after six weeks.

4. Transfer of the data

Your personal data can if necessary by the organizer, as far as the passing on the data is required to be passed on to the health authority.

5. Furthermore, we would like to inform you about your rights under the GDPR

If your data is processed, you have the right to information about yourself to receive stored data (Art. 15 GDPR). If incorrect personal data is processed, you have the right to do so Correction to (Art. 16 GDPR). If the legal requirements are met, you can delete or restrict your data request processing and object to processing (Art. 17, 18 and 21 para. 1 GDPR). Should you make use of your rights mentioned above, the organizer checks whether the legal requirements for this have been met.
